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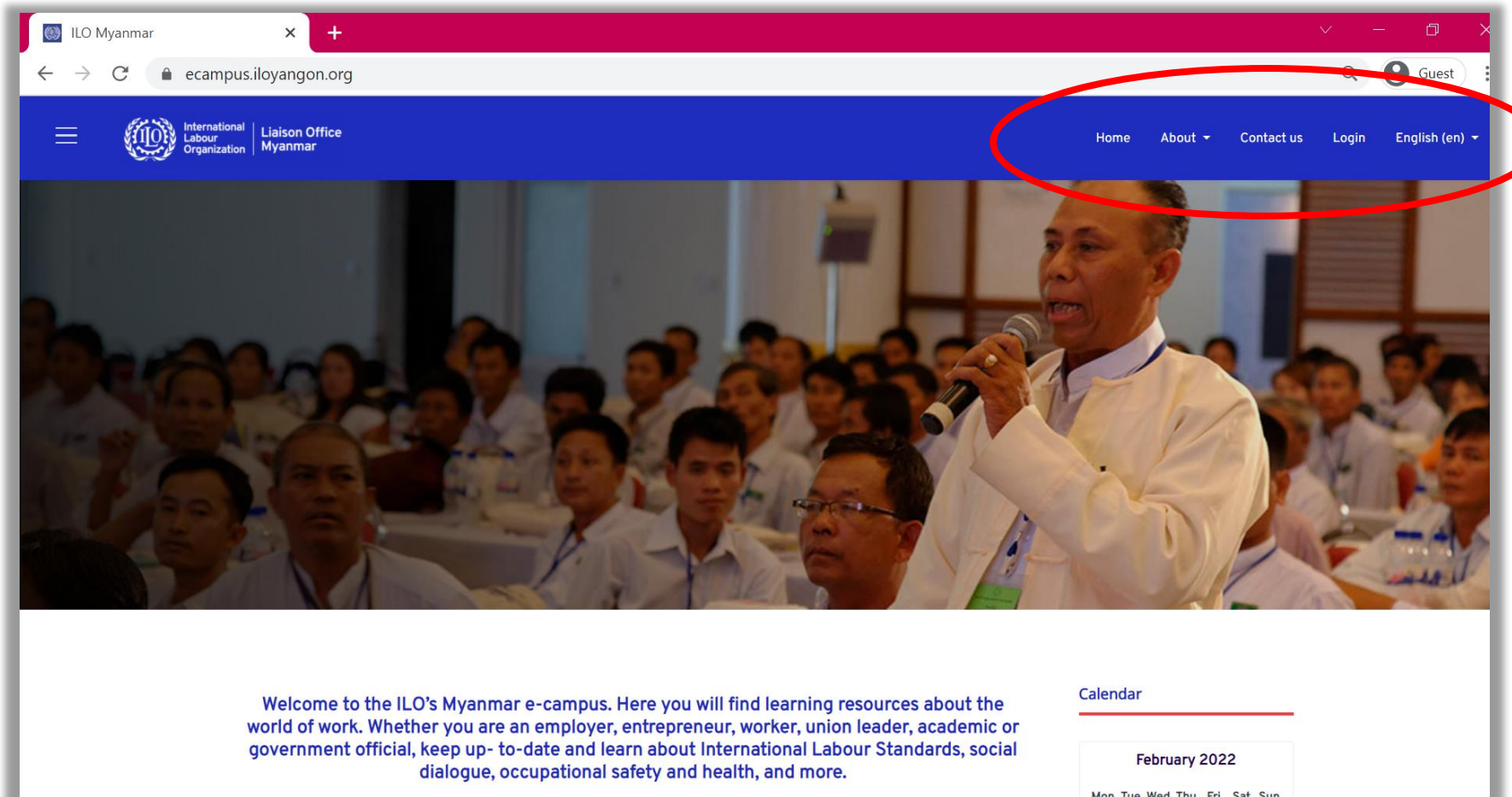

1. E-campus tour



Let's explore the functions of the tabs in the e-campus!

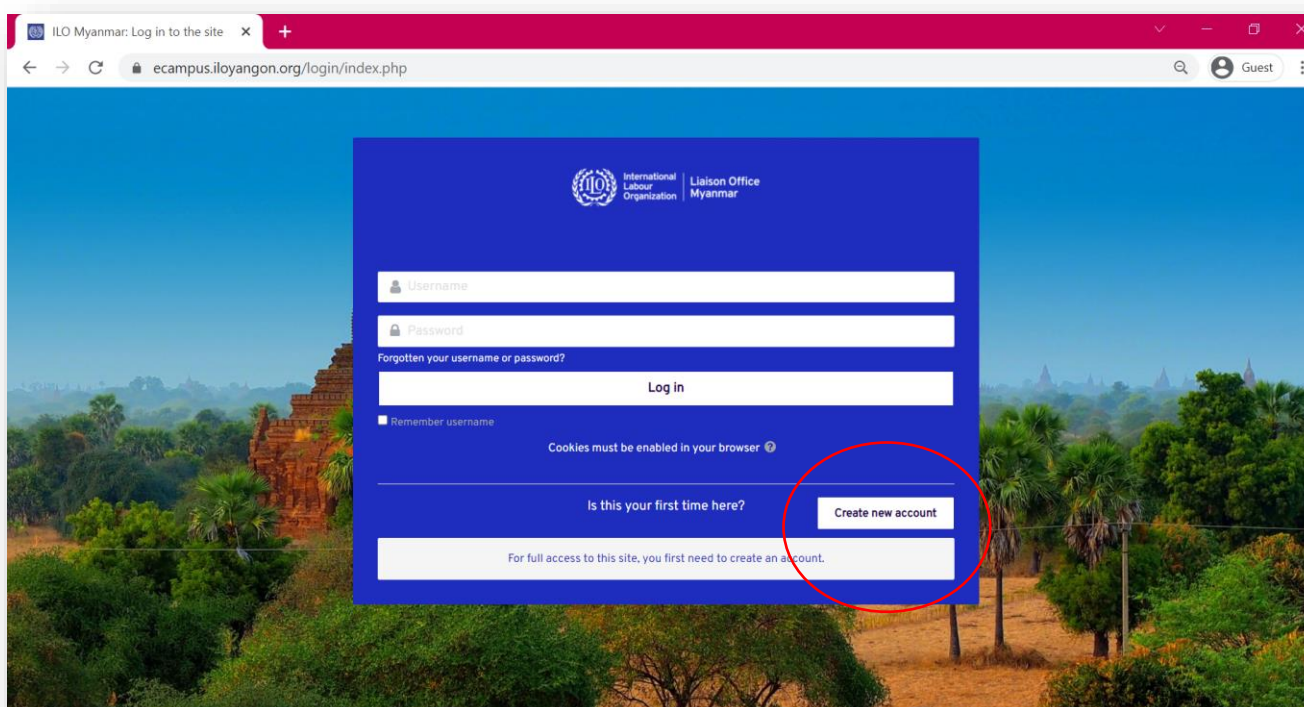
- Home → This features the courses available.
- About → This features resources that are useful, including this user manual, course catalogue, FAQs, and information on the Myanmar e-campus.
- Contact us → This includes information on how to contact the ILO user administration for the site.
- Log in → This is for registering a new user's account, as well as logging into the e-campus.
- English (en) → This allows you to choose your preferred language.
ဗမာစာ (my) → The e-campus is available in English and Burmese languages.

2. Signing up and new user registration

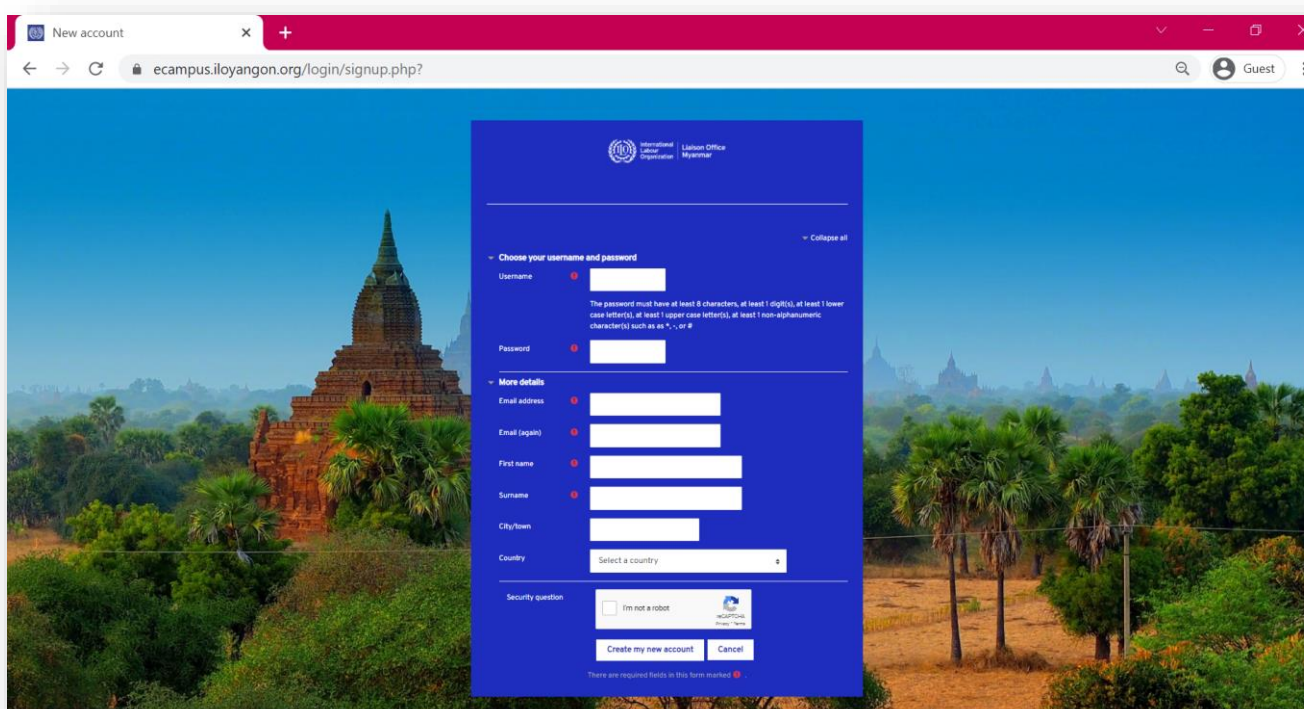
Important:

- To sign up, you must have a valid email address and access to it.

Step 1. Click on the “log in” or click on any course and you will see the following. As a new user, please click “create new account”.




Step 2. Type the information requested to sign up as a new user.



Notes:


- Your “username” is your unique digital identity. Do choose your username wisely!
- Your “password” accompanies your username each time you log in. Please choose your password with at least 8 characters, at least 1 digit(s), at least 1 lower case letter(s), at least 1 upper case letter(s), at least 1 non-alphanumeric character(s) such as as *, -, or #



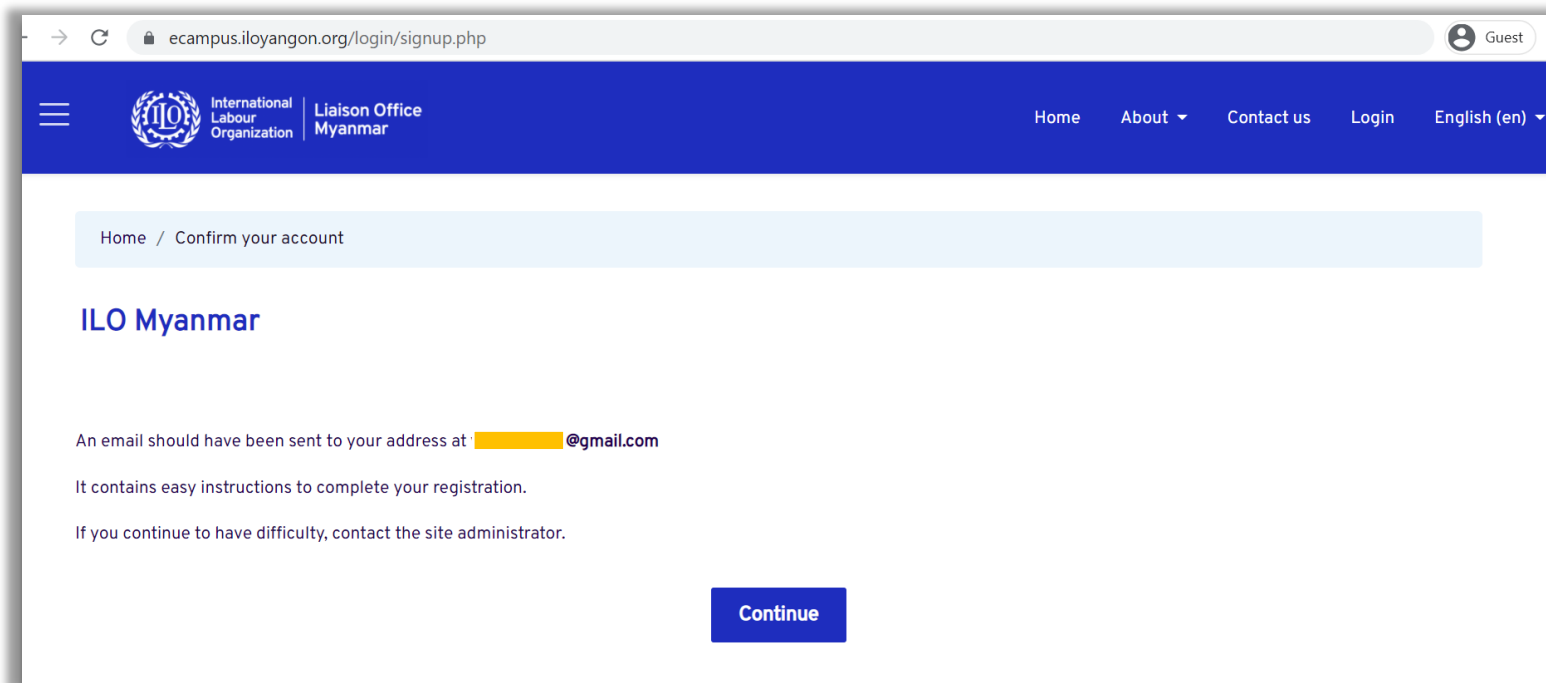
- Remember your Username and Password! Please write them down so you remember them for next time.

Also:

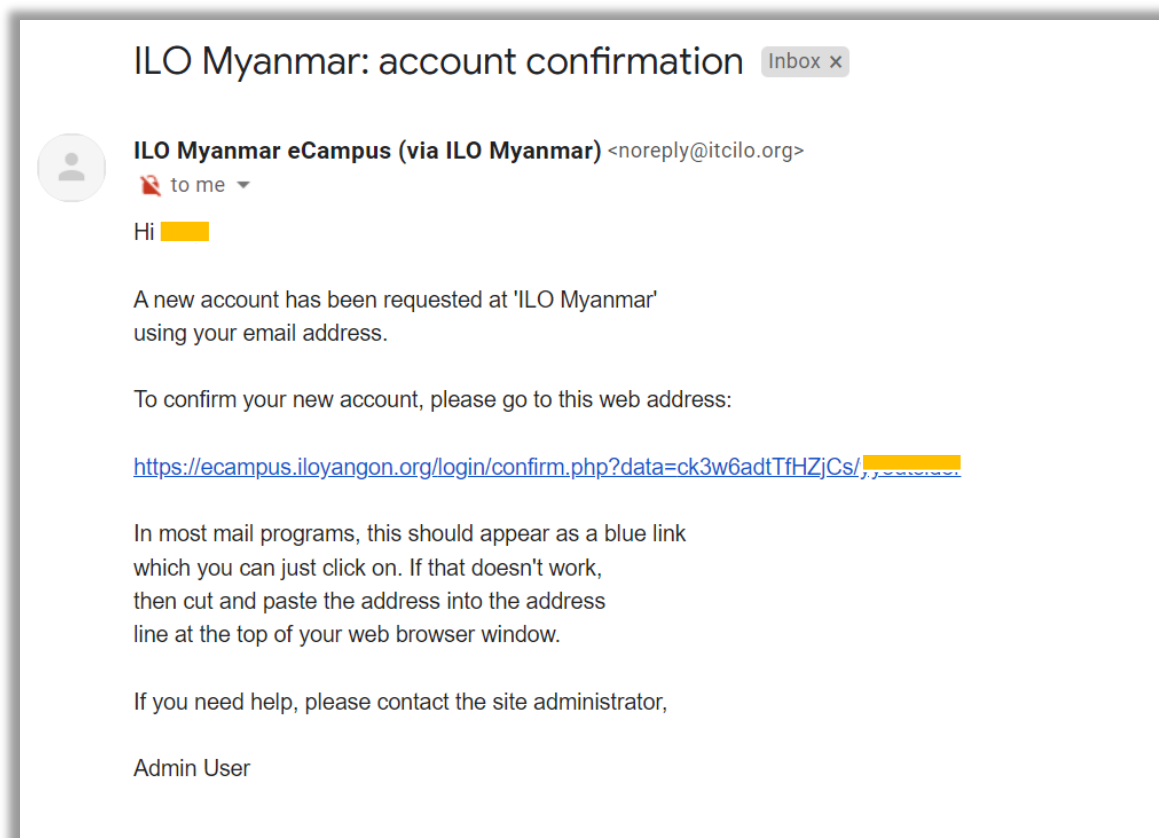
- Don't forget to click the “I am not a robot” button.



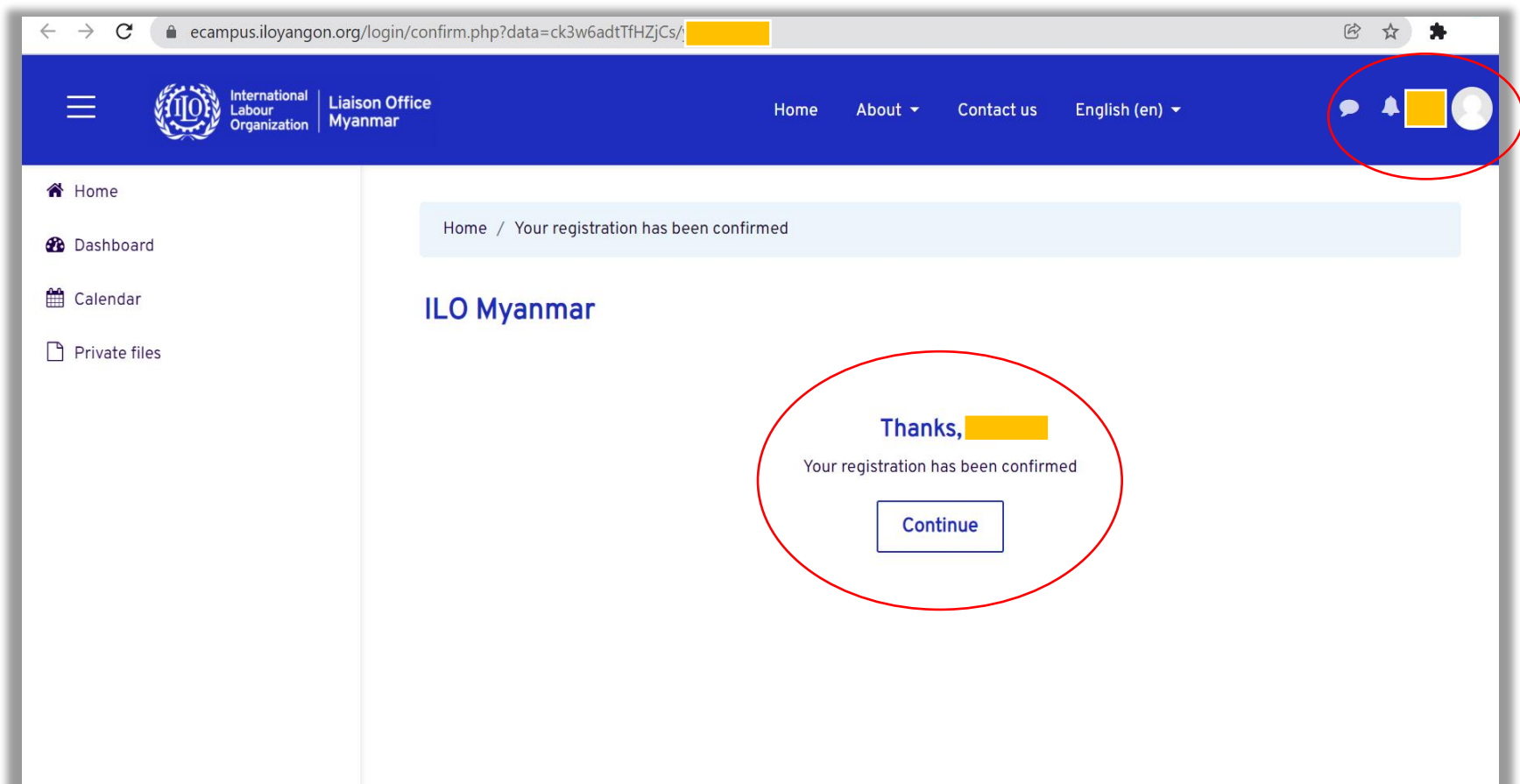
If you have successfully completed Step 1 and 2, you will see the following. Congratulations! You are half way there.



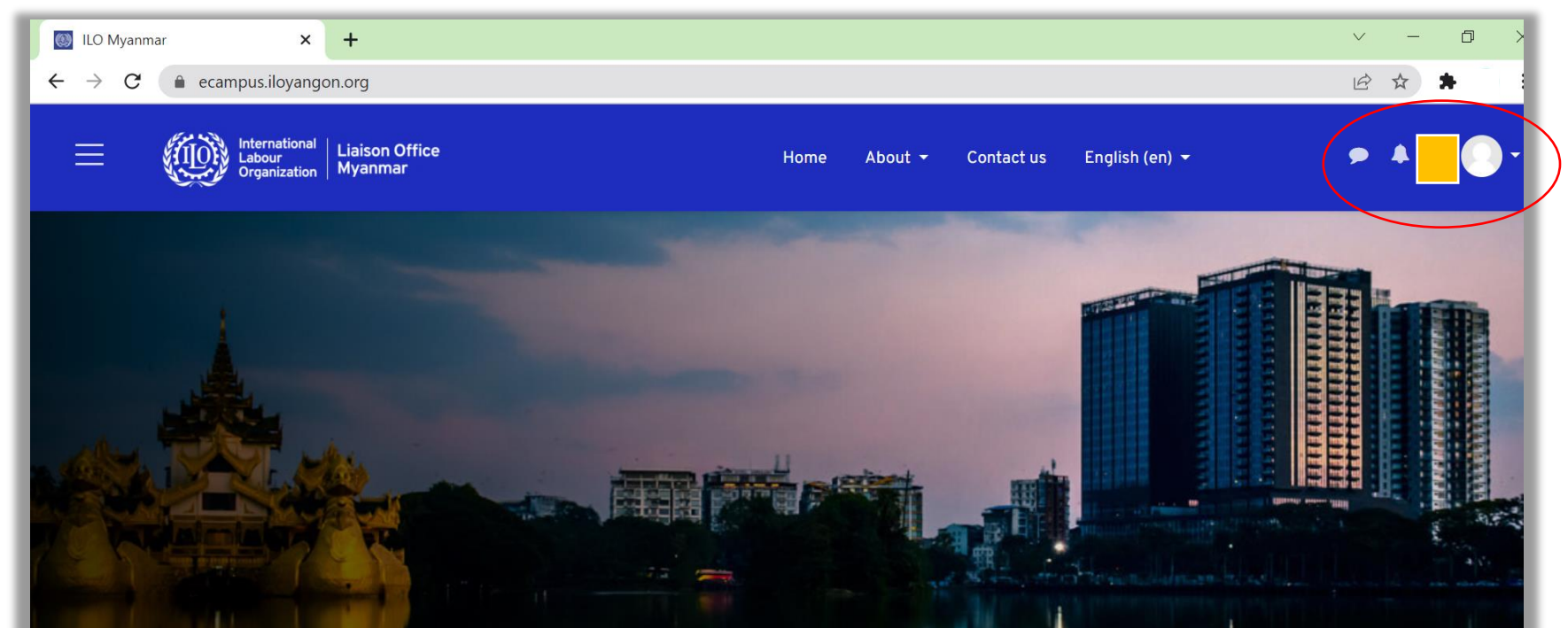
Step 3. Go to your email inbox and click on the blue link provided in the email.



Once you see the following, you have completed the registration!

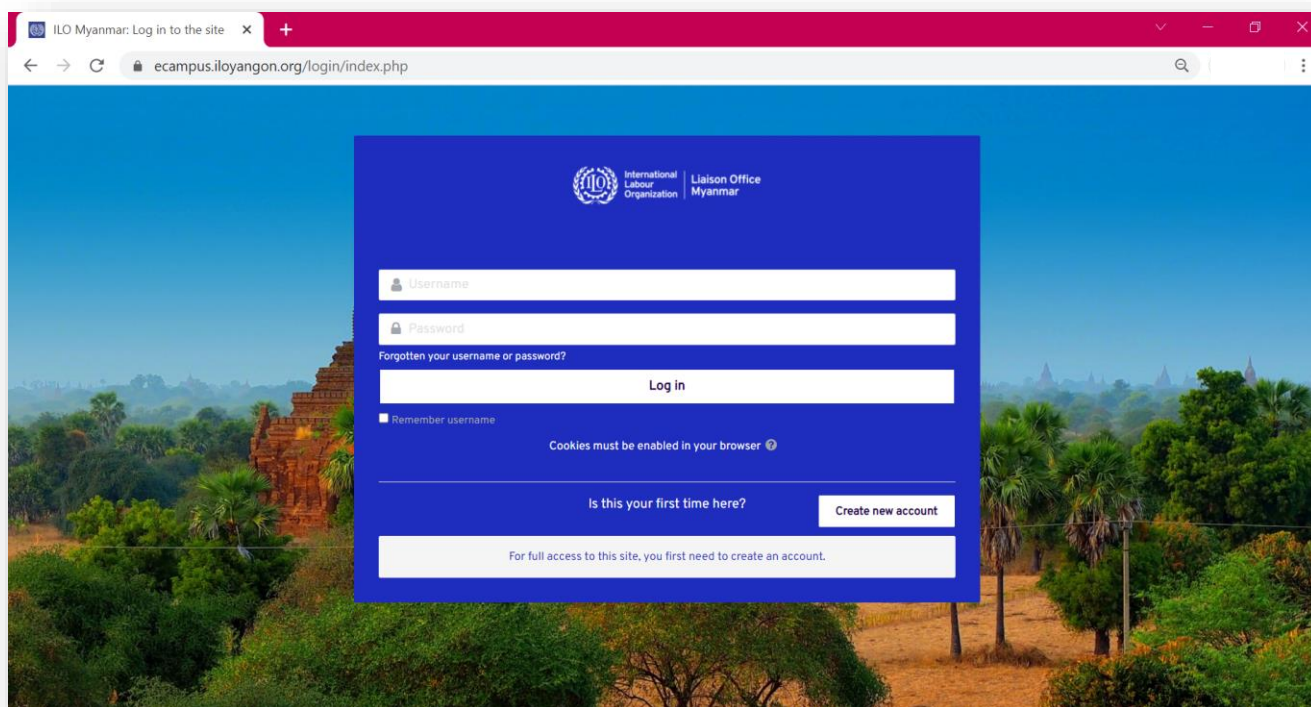


If you see your “username” in left hand corner as shown by red circle, you have successfully signed in to the e-campus with your account.

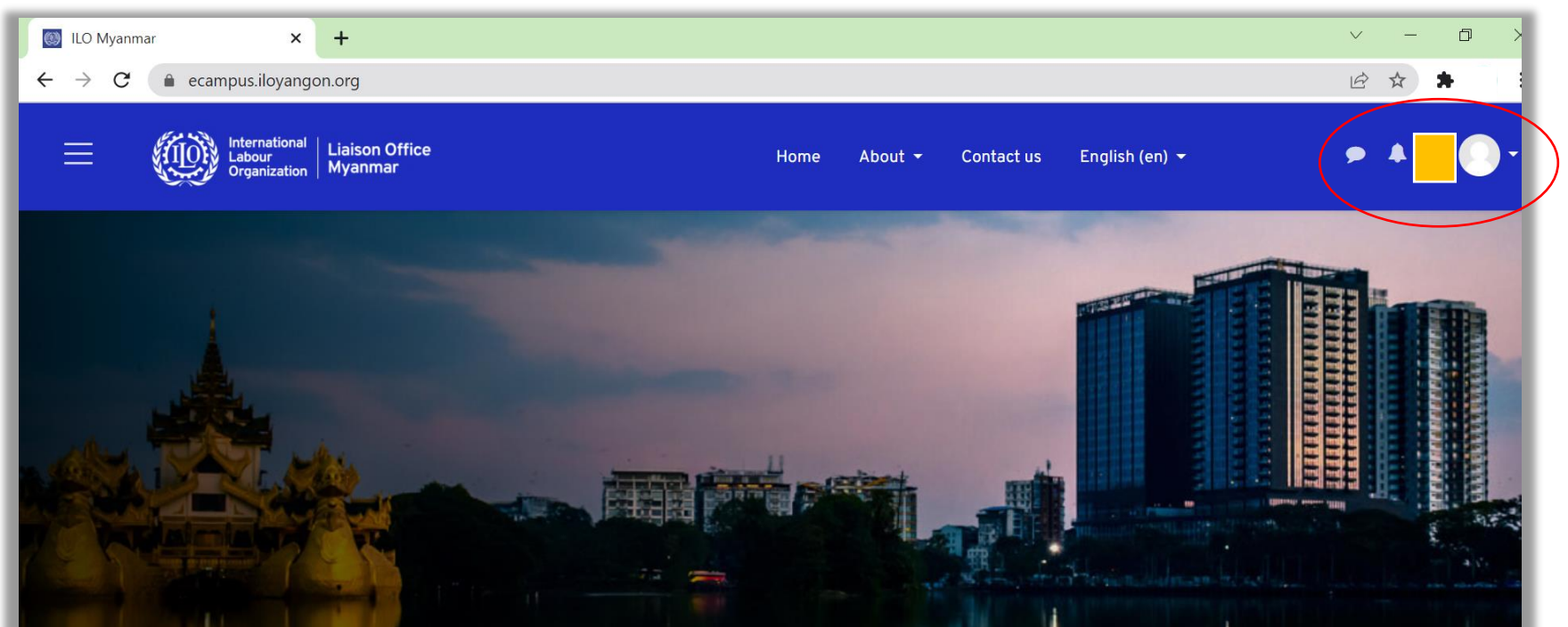


3. Logging in as a returning user

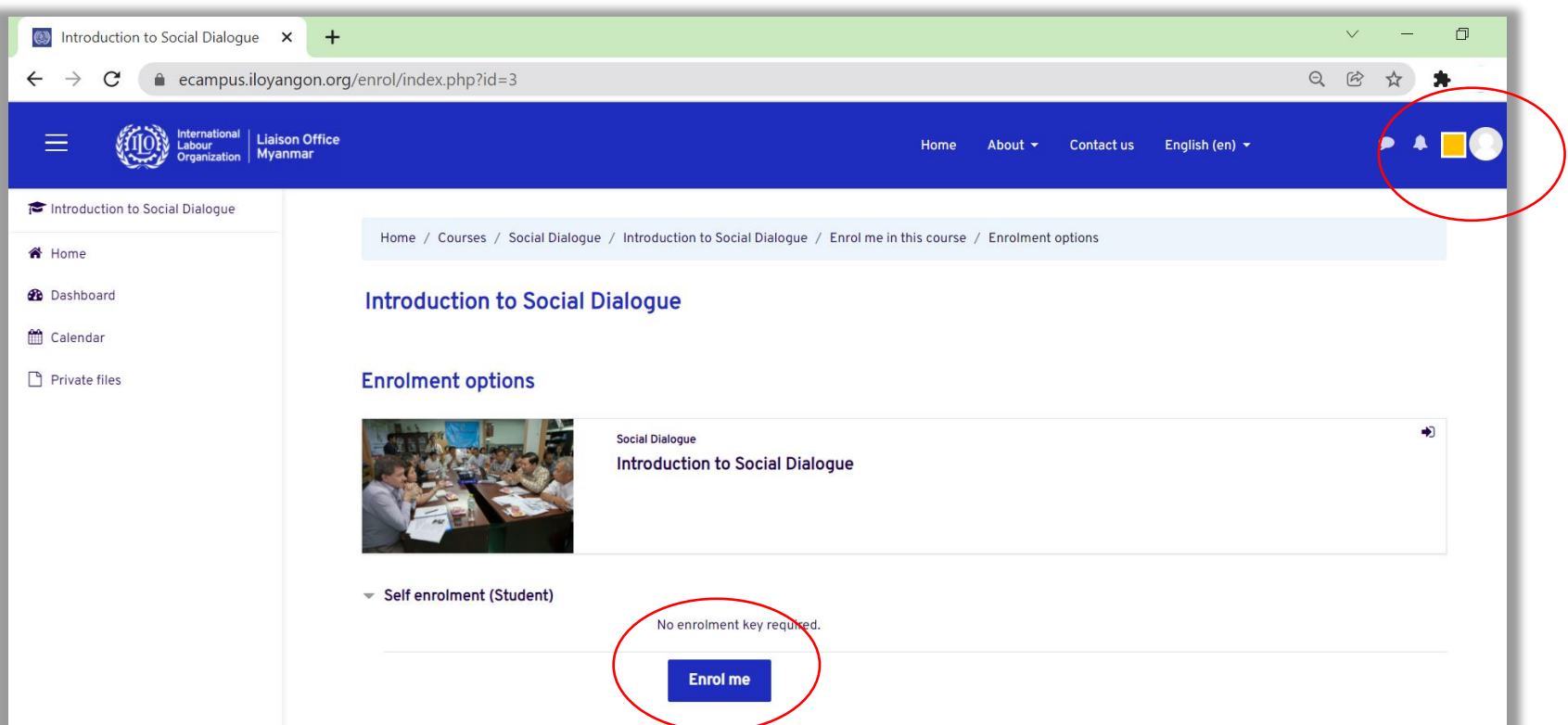
If you see your “username” in left hand corner as shown by red circle, you have successfully signed in to the e-campus with your account. Welcome back!



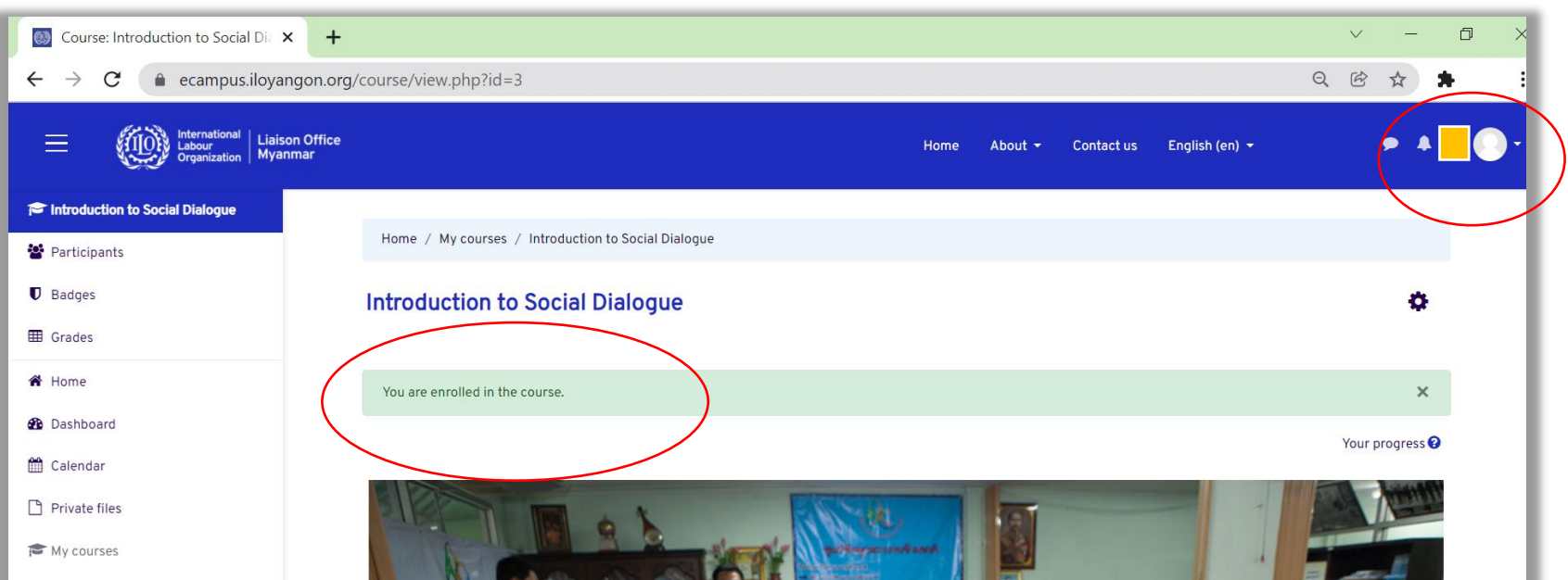
4. Enrolling in courses
